IAQA Chapter Updates, Florida Mold Bill Update, Chinese Drywall Overview, Chinese Drywall Remediation Protocol Review

Speaker: Sven R. Pavlovics, B.Sc., CMC, Environmental Scientist

Sven R. Pavlovics, B.Sc.,CMC, Environmental Scientist, founder and CEO of eamlabs. Mr. Pavlovics has over 30 years of environmental chemistry and microbiology experience. He began in the air pollution industry conducting stack testing, voc testing, radon and asbestos testing and analysis and continued in the hazardous waste industry conducting soil and groundwater pollution studies. He served as health and safety officer in consulting firm divisions and on numerous hazardous waste projects. Responsibilities included the health and safety of hazardous waste workers and implementation and maintenance of health monitoring systems. He served as QA officer at several companies and designed and built analytical systems analyzing soil, water and air samples. He continued on to project and division management of large corporations and facilities. He started eamlabs in 1997 conducting environmental chemistry and microbiological research and natural attenuation studies of groundwater and soil contaminant plumes using a mobile laboratory. In 1999, eamlabs began conducting indoor air quality analyses in addition to environmental chemistry analyses. This evolved into complete building envelope science studies. He instructs the IAQA CMC, CMI, CMR and CMRS classes at Florida Atlantic University. He is the director of the Palm Beach/Treasure Coast Chapter of the IAQA and serves on the CMC board and the IAQA Chapter Relations Committee.

Mr. Bassett is currently serving on the Florida Building Commission representing mechanical and electrical engineers. He serves, as a Commissioner, on the Energy Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and is Chairman of the Mechanical TAC. Mr. Bassett is a Fellow of the Florida Engineering Society and the National Society of Professional Engineers. He was Engineer of the Year in 2002 of the Florida Engineering Society.
