Correlating Particles, Health, and Microbial Growth

Speaker: Richard Johnson, President, Air Allergen & Mold Testing, Inc.

Multiple evidence based studies suggest higher levels of particulate in the indoor air can have an adverse effect on the health of the occupants. This presentation will discuss particulate found in spore traps; how the sampling of particulate from spore traps relates to the use of particle counters, how particulate count varies between locations within a home, how particulate counts correlate to otherwise identified microbial issues, how particle counts relate to health concerns; how particulate investigations relate to the work of IAQ professionals and supporting industries. Richard Johnson is the Co-Chairman of the Fulton County Asthma Improvement and Reduction Coalition (FAIR) and has been conducting IAQ Evaluations for more than 15 years.

Michael Lucas, deputy director of AVLF, will share how issues such as mold, roach infestations, poor ventilation, filtration, and moisture have impacts far beyond the health of the occupants, including educational performance, and how neighborhood-based strategies to address those issues can improve education. Michael Lucas became Deputy Director of AVLF in 2014. He holds a Master's in Social Work from the University of Texas and a law degree from the University of California at Berkeley.
